The above school fees incorporate tuition fees, curriculum fee, co-curricular activities, stationery and excursions.

School fee accounts are issued on a quarterly basis, payable one term in advance. Fees will be issued as follows:

First term	November 2021
Second term	February 2022
Third term	May 2022
Fourth term	August 2022

These fees are payable within two weeks of receipt of the Account. There is the option to pay fees on a weekly, fortnightly or monthly basis via a credit card or bank account direct debit authority.

School Camps

The cost of camps are as follows:

Year 4	\$265 per child
Year 5	\$295 per child
Year 6	\$1,100 per child

These costs will be charged in Term 2 and are subject to change.

Miscellaneous Costs

- A School Magazine is produced during the year with the cost charged separately in Term 3.

Terms and Conditions relating to School fees

School fees will be charged on a quarterly basis payable one term in advance.

School fees must be paid annually in advance or termly in advance or by direct debit (weekly / fortnightly / monthly) unless other arrangements are agreed with the Business Manager.

For fees paid annually in advance by 12th November a 3% discount will be allowed.

The school fees for the first term of attendance at the school must be paid or a direct debit commenced by the 11th November in the year prior to commencement.

Students may not be allowed to enter a new term at the Primary School while the fees for the previous term are unpaid, unless payment terms have been agreed and accepted by the Business Manager in advance.

The Primary School may charge a late payment fee if any amount is overdue at the end of a calendar month. In addition, interest may be charged by applying a rate as approved by the Council of Immanuel Primary School from time to time to the balance overdue on the account at the end of each month. The Primary School may take all steps it considers necessary to recover monies owed to it, including professional debt collection services and legal action. All fees, charges and commissions arising as a result of such actions will be payable by the person(s) who sign the acceptance of offer form or Re-enrolment form.

The Primary School will charge a family account for any bank fees and related administration charges arising if a payment is dishonoured or rejected by the financial institution specified.

Where a direct debit arrangement is entered into, the dollar value of the regular debits will be increased with effect November each year, by the same percentage as the general movement in fees approved by Council of Immanuel Primary School for the following school year. The Primary School shall obtain permission from the person who initially authorised the direct debit before increasing the value of the regular debits for any other reason.

At least one term's notice must be given before withdrawing your child/ren from the school during the year. For new enrolments and re-enrolments commencing from the start of a new school year, written notification must be given by the 30th October. If a student leaves the school without giving the required notice, one term's fees in lieu are payable.
